
Self-Assign Training Modules – CATS

- 1. Self-assignment in CATS is currently only available for OCP-Photography and Videography of Research Animals, which is required for all those employees and students working on a protocol with live animals. *Note:* This is currently the only course available because it is a course only taken once. When you self-assign a course, they are considered "Optional" and are not automatically reassigned when they become due. You would have to repeat this process.
- 2. In order to self-assign the course, please follow the below instructions.
- 3. Log into CATS
 - Note: If this is your first time accessing the new training platform, you may have to log in using your LSUHSC-NO credentials (SSO).
 - Note: Firefox and Google Chrome are preferred browsers. Safari and Internet Explorer are NOT supported.
- 4. Click on **LEARNING LIBRARY** to review training modules available for self-assignment.

5. Hover over the training module and Click **ENROLL**. You'll be asked to confirm enrollment prior to beginning the course.



- 7. You can go back to the Learning Library at any point and return to complete the training in the future.




• Click "Resume" to continue the training.

 is no need to provide the certificate in Kuali unless your training does not populate in
 the Protocol Personnel Table of the application.
